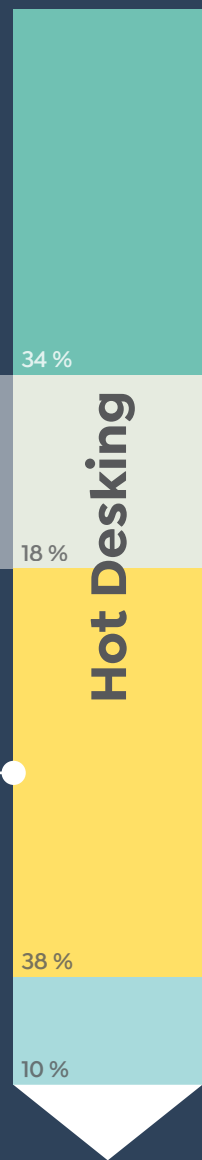


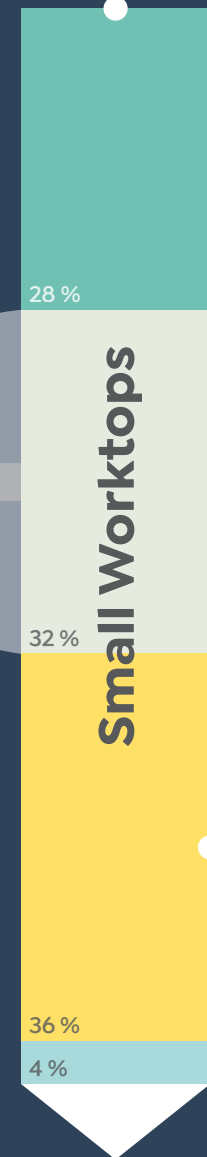
Office Changes Post COVID-19

Less Common

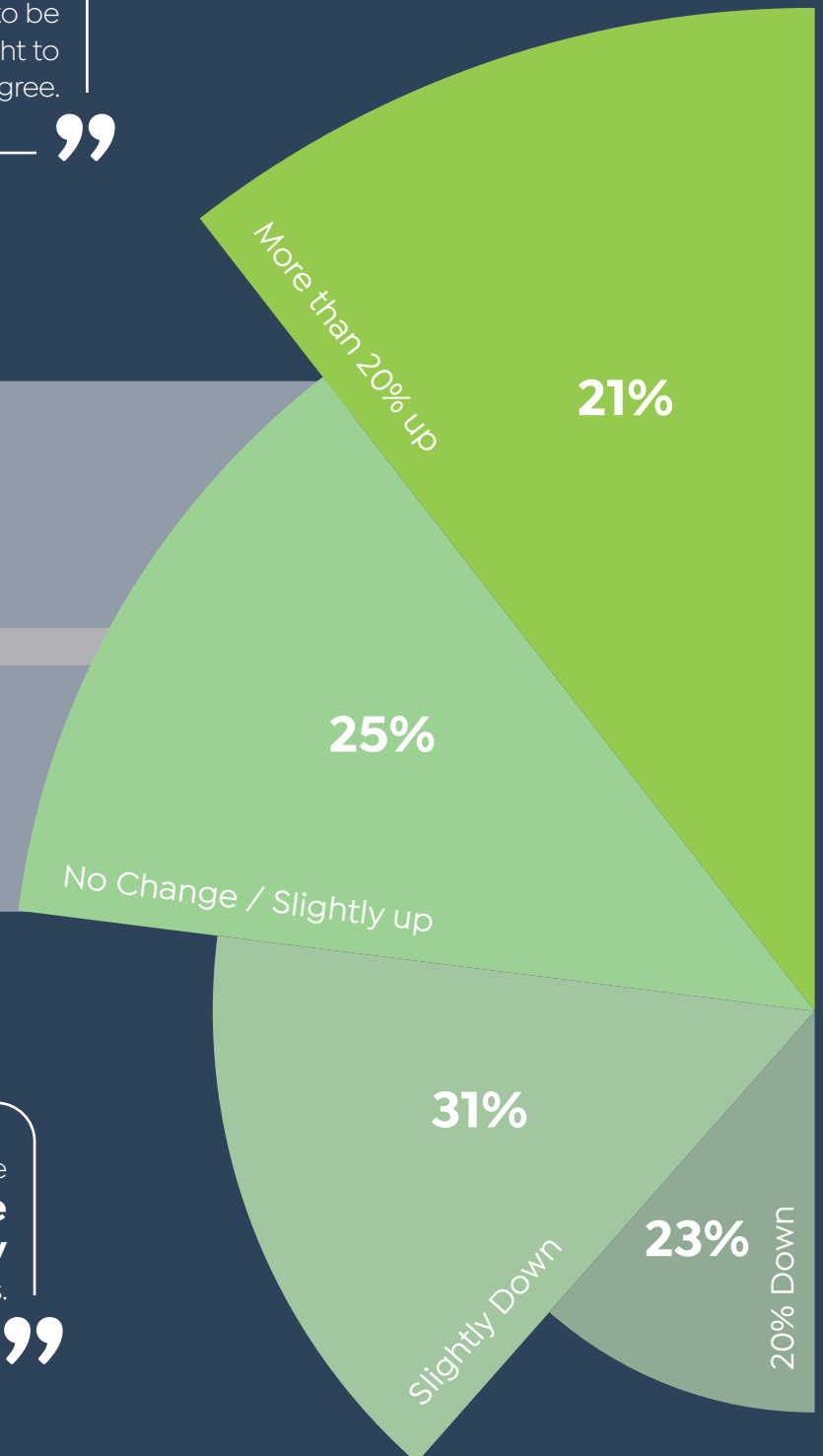
“Collaboration spaces **will not reduce** although I do believe they will become **larger spaces** to ensure social distancing can be achieved.”
